Easy Pancakes

Ingredients - 100g Plain Flour, 2 Large Eggs, 300ml Milk, 1 tbsp vegetable oil or melted butter, extra for cooking. Lemon wedges, to serve. Caster sugar, to serve.

Method – 1. Put the flour, eggs, milk and 1tbsp. oil/butter with a pinch of salt into a bowl or large jug. Whisk to a smooth batter. Set aside to rest for at least thirty minutes, if you have the time. 2. Set a pan over a medium heat and wipe it with some oiled kitchen paper (careful not to burn your fingers). When the pan is hot cook each pancake for one minute on each side until golden, keeping them in a warm oven as you go. 3. Serve with caster sugar and lemon wedges or maple syrup. Freeze for up to two months stacked between sheets of baking parchment.

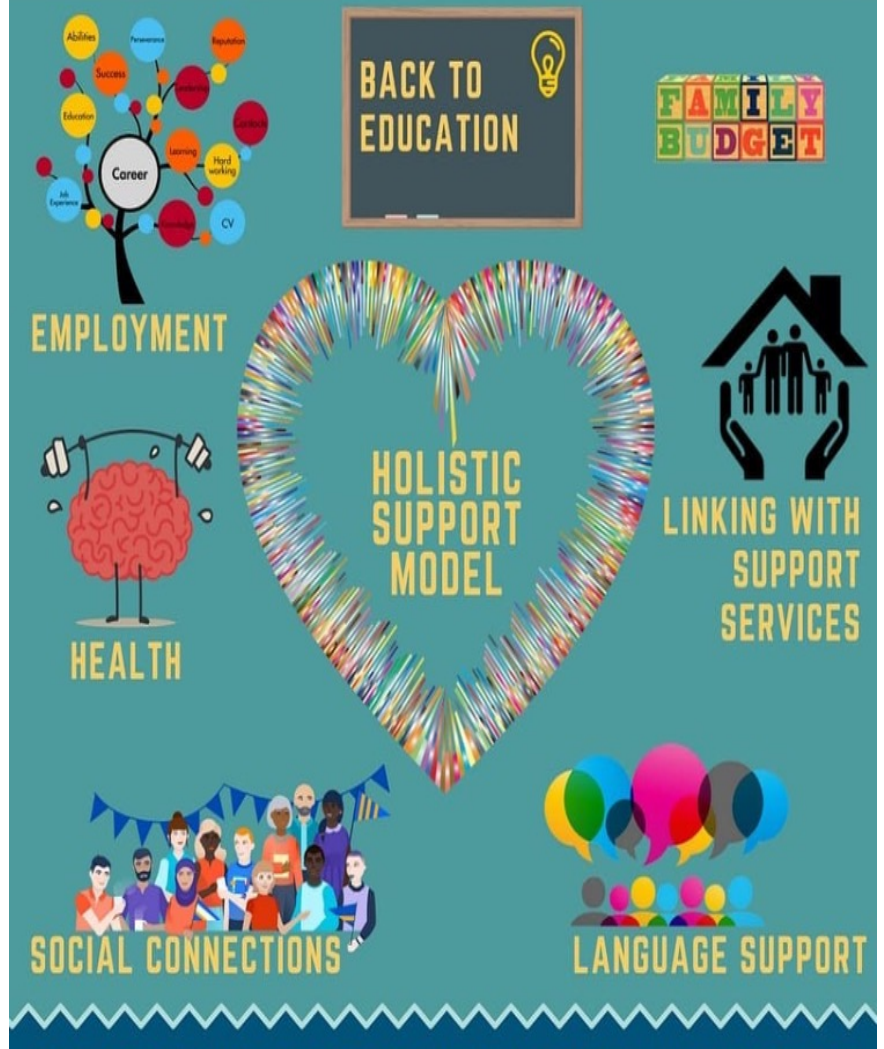
