Prayer at the close of day

Beginning on Thursday 25th February at 8.00pm in the Chapel of Memory. We will meet for this short service of prayer each Thursday evening during Lent. Compline is the last service of the day in the Christian tradition of Canonical hours. It has been a feature of worship since the 6th Century and was adopted by the Anglican Church in the 1920's.
