The 31st October 2017 marks the 500th anniversary of the Reformation. In 1517AD, Martin Luther nailed 95 theses to the door of All Saints Church, Wittenberg in Germany.

To commemorate this important event we at Zion School will create a modern day discourse with 95 contributions. These will be presented in the form of a pamphlet. Unlike the original they will not be a critique of any church or body, but their orientation will be reform from within our own selves. We will share with others something vital that we have learned, or carried with us as nourishment for our souls. Your contribution can be in the form of:

- A passage from the Bible, or any Holy Book that you draw on for inspiration.

- It can be a saying that you heard.

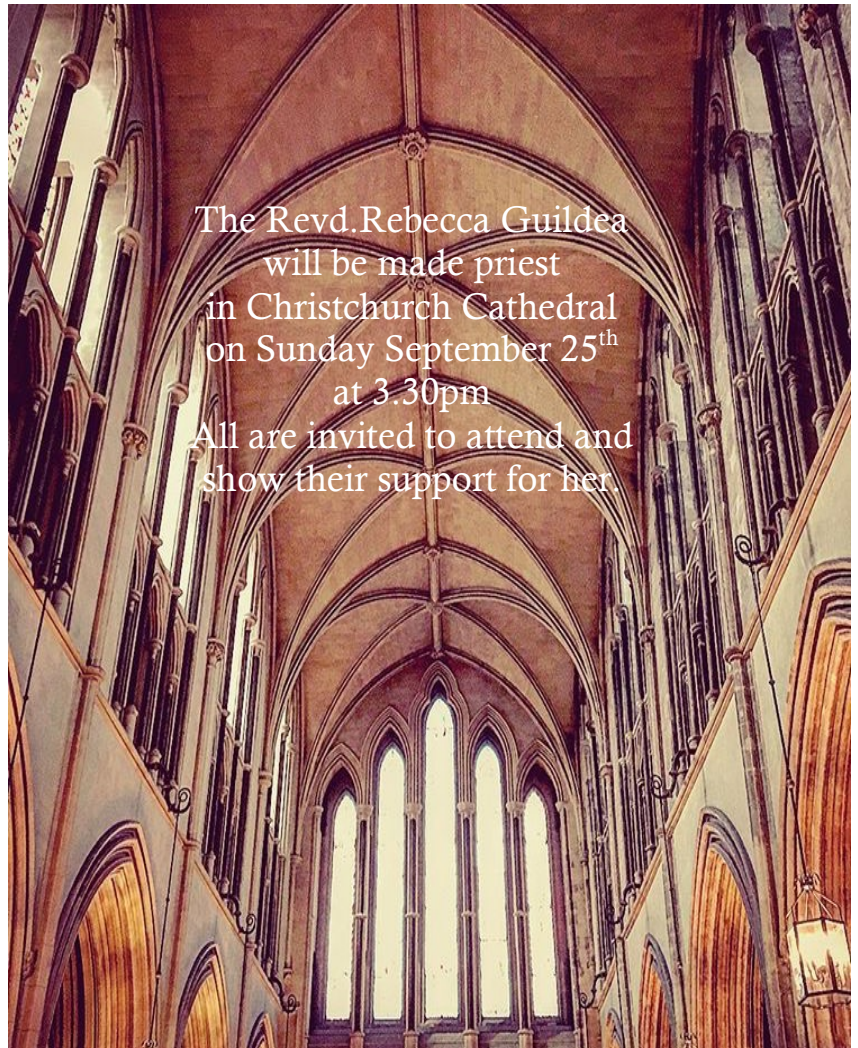
